- Encourage the inclusion of ethnic minorities






Educational messages

The Discovery Club in Leiden, The Netherlands







OBJECTIVES

- Engage and entertain refugee children with STEAM
- Provide a space for children and parents to interact with and experience their local environment
- Provide access to basic STEAM education to refugee children
- Stimulate interactions between cultures and a sense of world citizenship
- Provide some stability while they are in an emergency shelter



CHALLENGES

- Lack of communication between organisations offering activities for refugees
- Lack of support from local policy makers
- Difficulty to find long-term funding
- Time consuming (volunteering)
- Activities and volunteers need to be flexible for content, ages, languages
- Lack of communication and stability with the policy makers



SUCCESSES

- A lot of volunteers showed interest in participating
- Excellent feedbacks and links with the kids and parents
- Continuity from February 2016 offer visible progress for some kids
- Many lessons learnt!
