

About the podcast

Two hosts- techjournalist Anders Høeg Nissen and astrophysicist Tina Ibsen.

Started in 2019 - 74 episodes to date.

Approx 10.000 listeners per episode.



Why a podcast?

Intimate

You listen to podcast in your own time. Often alone using headphones.

Imaginative and aesthetic

Listening to podcasts creates an auditory and imaginative experience in your head.
Sense of hearing is hyper aesthetic and sensitive.

It works

"podcasts have been demonstrated to improve scientific uptake in students, medical patients and the public"

Using the podcast format

01

Easier to develop a relationship

Making the audience feel like they are part of the conversation going on in the studio.

02

Chumcast

... in which two or more hosts riff off each other, chatting in a casual or rambunctious manner around a theme, making the listener feel included in a private no-holds-barred conversation.

03

Live shows

Meeting the audience f2f, and giving them a chance to contribute and develop a deeper relationship with podcast.



- Start every episode with conversation about news.


