
## Workshops and the project stand

The workshops will be carried out next to the project stand which will be installed in three different locations (all with free access) so that people can easily visit them. The first two locations will focus more on students and their families while the third location will be an open space. This will enable any kind of public to engage with the stand. We will link the activities with the content of the project's stand. For the workshops: we will have a sensory accessibility exercise, an instruments making workshop with a 3D printer, cards game, and more. All of them are music-related or senses-related depending on the theme of the week. The workshops will be carried out from 9.30 to 16.00 and they will be open for everybody visiting the venues and the stand.

## Science Café

The science café is scheduled on 27 June at 11.00 in the school area. The event will take place in an informal atmosphere where all attendees will be encouraged to participate. We want to trigger a discussion based on the themes covered by the music articles and research. We expect around 50 participants to the science café, mostly high school students.

ERC grantee Xavier Serra, supervisor of the <u>Audio Signal Processing Lab research of the MTG</u>, will give a presentation of his research to 30 teachers who will attend the iMusciCa summer school organised by Ellinogermaniki Agogi in Marathon.
