José Mariano Gago (1948 - 2015) was key figure of European science engagement. He was a founder of the Portuguese Ciência Viva network of science centres and an active contributor to Ecsite activities over the years.

THE PRIZE

The 2017 Awards ceremony will be taking place on 15 June 2017, during the Opening ceremony of the Ecsite Annual Conference in Porto, Portugal.

Winners are invited to spread their ideas by orchestrating a workshop for their peers at the exclusive Ecsite Directors Forum (4-6 October 2017, Paris, France). They also get exposure in the Ecsite magazine and on the Ecsite website.

TWO CATEGORIES FOR 2017

This year we have a 'classic' submit your own project category AND a **new peer-nominated category**.

The 'Smart and Simple' Award celebrates simple, innovative and creative solutions in science engagement. It recognises the power of smart ideas that prompt a "I wish I had thought of that one!" reaction from other professionals.

Step 1: peer nominations by 2 April

Step 2: extra information from nominees by 23 April

The 'Sustainable Success' Award celebrates longlasting impact: projects that embody the values of science engagement, that are visionary and socially relevant.

For this category, organisations put their own applications in, by 23 April

In 2015 the first ever Ecsite Award was dedicated to creativity. The **Norsk Teknisk Museum**, Oslo (Norway) was the winner for TING, a participatory and immersive exhibition experience exploring the **complex relationships between technology and democracy**.

In 2016 the **Strategic Partnership Award** recognised extraordinary collaborative working between an Ecsite member and an external partner to achieve goals neither of them could have reached by themselves alone.

Tekniska Museet, Stockholm (Sweden) won for its **partnership undertaken with artist** Håkan Lidbo on the interactive exhibit "Make Music with Your Whole Body", co-created with children and taking into account the needs of physically impaired visitors.

The Jury also nominated a Highly commended project: International Centre for Life, Newcastle (UK) - for their partnership built with the Northumbria University, a continuing programme of activities that reinforces both partners' mission and vision.

Like the ever-developing field of science itself, the Mariano Gago Ecsite Awards are dynamic, with categories changing each year.

We are seeking support to enable the awards to grow even further. For instance, we would like to provide organisational development prizes to winners, and to boost communications tools to widen the awards' reach.
