#### e-STONIA

Estonia ranks among the most wired and technologically advanced countries in the world. With a high internet penetration rate and widespread e-commerce and e-government services embedded into the daily lives of individuals and organizations, Estonia has become a model for free Internet access as a

development engine for society. When the country regained independence in 1991 after nearly 50 years of Soviet rule, its infrastructure was in disastrous condition. The country's new leadership, however, perceived the expansion information and communication technologies (ICTs) as a key to economic growth and invested heavily in their development.

Estonia is also unique in many other ways. Did you know that it is ranked second in Europe for the number of visible bird species (after Spain?) Estonia is the fifth country in Europe in terms of forest cover. Nowhere else in Europe can you find so many different wild animals; including bears, wolves and lynxes... According to studies, Estonia is the least religious country in the world. We have more nature-cameras installed in inaccessible places than any other

country. Russians, Swedes and Germans have occupied Estonia. All have left their marks on our landscapes and culture. Rightly or wrongly they have helped define who we are.

When regained independence in 1991, Ilves became Ambassador of Estonia to the United States in 1993, also serving as Ambassador to Canada and Mexico at government as Minister of Foreign Affairs from 1996 to 1998 and again from 1999 to 2002. Later, he was a Member of the European Parliament from 2004 to 2006.
