

MUSE hosting Europe's largest science communication conference

TRENTO, ITALY – Ecsite, the European network of science centres and museums, will draw up to **1,000 science communicators** from over 45 countries to its Annual Conference held this year at MUSE – Museo delle Scienze in Trento, Italy. It is open to all professionals working in science centres or museums, natural history museums, universities, aquaria, zoos, research institutes and private companies in the field. The conference will be celebrating its **26th edition**.

The three-day event will run 11-13 June 2015 and showcase the latest research and developments in **public engagement with science** through dynamic sessions, debates, workshops and a **trade show** called the Business Bistro. Pre-conference meetings and workshops, held two days prior to the main conference (9-10 June 2015), will give in-depth insight into numerous aspects of the science communication field.

The programme offers a diverse mix of more than **90 sessions delivered by over 350 speakers**, ranging from practical advice on how to conceive interactive exhibits to discussions on the sector's contribution in tackling global issues linked to this year's **theme**: **"Food for curious minds**". Other topics include immersive experiences, travelling exhibitions, responsible research, staff exchanges, teenage audiences, or synthetic biology.

High profile guest speakers will be:

- Entrepreneur Andrea Illy, Chairman/CEO of illycaffè (Italy)

More than **50 exhibitors** will be showcasing their latest products and services at the buzzing Business Bistro and participants will be able to get hands-on in **two workshop spaces**, the Maker space and the Game Lab. Not to forget the many networking opportunities like the Newcomers' breakfast or the Gala dinner, held at a beautiful winery at the foot of the Dolomite Mountains.

Designed by **Renzo Piano**, host museum MUSE – Museo delle Scienze opened its doors in July 2013. Its striking architecture and beautifully designed exhibitions tell the story of mountain environments. It has quickly established itself as a lively arena for citizens to lead informed discussions about challenges of the future.
