COVID rules and restrictions, as of 9 November:

Masks are no longer obligatory in the Cité.

Health Pass is required for anyone over 12 years old.

Health Pass: Vaccine certification OR negative Antigen/PCR test done within the last 72 hours OR for persons who have had COVID-19: the result of a positive RT-PCR or Antigen test, attesting that the individual has been infected, and that a period of time of at least 11 days and less than 6 months has passed since the test result was obtained (considered as a recovery certificate).
