

Towers of Tomorrow with LEGO Bricks partners up some of the world's most dazzling and innovative skyscrapers with the world's most popular building brick.



Young and old will be limited only by their imagination as they add their creations to a steadily rising futuristic LEGO metropolis inside the exhibition.
