



Universcience is launching a fundraiser for Ukrainian citizens and scientists

To show support to the Ukrainian people, Universcience offers its visitors the opportunity to donate 2 euros for each ticket that they purchase to the French Red Cross. For the first 5,000 tickets, Universcience will donate to the PAUSE national program that helps scientists in exile.

In response to the urgent situation that Ukrainian citizens are facing, Universcience offers its visitors the possibility, from March 8 to March 13, to make a 2 euros donation for every ticket they purchase for the Cité des sciences et de l'industrie and Les Étincelles du Palais de la découverte. The funds collected will be donated to the French Red Cross for its "Conflit Ukraine 2022" campaign.

This donation offer applies to all of the activities available at the Cité and Les Étincelles, online or in situ, with the exception of tickets for workshops and tickets bought through resellers. Visitors with a subscription card or a free entry pass will also be able to contribute.

Universcience, that presides over Ecsite, the European science centers network, is committing to doubling the first 5,000 donations with an additional 2 euros donation to the <u>PAUSE national program</u>, an initiative supported by the Collège de France and its "Solidarité avec l'Ukraine" ("Solidarity with Ukraine") call to action. These donations will help fund the emergency shelter of one Ukrainian researcher in need for 3 months.
